

This course carries one credit of experiential learning. I have attempted to integrate this requisite into the coursework. After observing (holistically) the progress toward meeting this fulfillment, I am convinced that the effort being put forth will not meet the course requirement. As a result, the EL part of this course will now become more formal. Each student will write an 8-10 page paper describing the project development process in this class. You have the option of using a journal style (i.e. class by class, meeting by meeting, deliverable by deliverable) but it must meet the following objectives:

1. Must incorporate lessons learned in class
2. Must include project meeting schedule (dates and times of all meetings)
3. Appendix must include ALL e-mail correspondences between members (i.e. you and your team)
4. Paper must include a meeting summary – i.e. topics discussed, obstacles overcome, lessons learned, things you would do differently
5. Summary should include an overview of the project experience – was it worth it? What would you do differently?
