

How to Create Anchors (Targets) on a Web Page using Nvu

An anchor (also called a target) is a location within a web page that you can move to quickly by clicking on text on the same web page. It is often used as a fast way to navigate a long web page. Go to <http://mason.gmu.edu/~scampbel/assignb.html> to see an example.

To create an anchor on a web page...

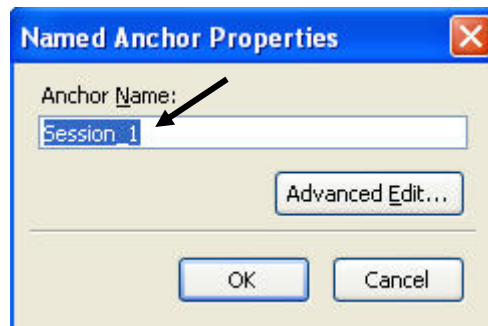
1. Move your cursor to the anchor location on the web page (the location on the web page to which you want to move quickly).
2. Highlight the first word at the anchor location.



3. Click on the “Anchor” icon on the toolbar.



NOTE: A “Named Anchor Properties” box will open up containing the highlighted text.



4. Click on “OK.”
5. Move the cursor to the text that you want to link to the anchor.

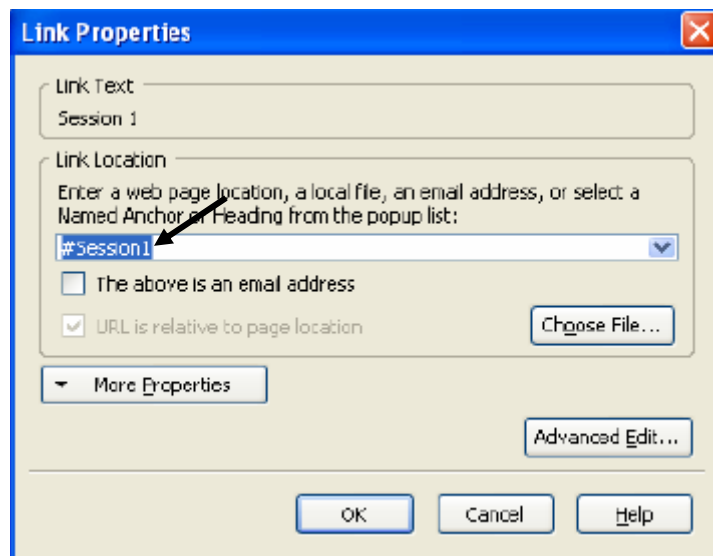
6. Highlight the text that you want to include in the link.



7. Click on the “Link” icon on the toolbar.



NOTE: The link properties box will appear with the link text preceded with a # symbol and highlighted.



8. Click on “OK.”
